

Honouring the Past Advisor – Volunteer position

We are seeking an Advisor to join the Geelong Cats Honouring the Past Committee.

The Honouring the Past Committee has been established to govern the preservation and promotion of the Geelong Football Club history and to honour and connect to the groups and individuals who have collectively made the Club the sporting institution that it is today, on behalf of the Geelong Football Club.

Committee responsibilities:

- Provide recommendations to the Board for Club and AFL recognition award recommendations.
- Provide advice on the following Club Management activities:
 - a) Provide advice on the Honouring the Past strategic plan;
 - b) Provide advice on Club policies and processes that oversee the preservation of the Club collections, memorabilia and artefacts are managed, stored and catalogued in accordance with Museums best practice;
 - c) Provide advice on the Geelong Cats History Society strategy;
 - d) Provide advice on the Club Past Players engagement strategy;
 - e) Provide advice on ensuring all Life Members, Hall of Fame and Legends of the Club are recognised as valued contributors appropriately; and
 - f) Advise on special projects, events and initiatives as required.

It is envisioned that the applicant will be subject matter experts on the Geelong Cats with a good understanding of the Club's 161-year history.

Meetings are held four times a year with consultation required from time to time between meetings. This is a voluntary role for a period of 12 months with opportunity to extend.
